Event Rules

Helmets Will Be Required. Child must be between the ages of **4 and 7 and weigh less than forty-five (45) lbs.** Rider may use a rope (put on by COMMITTEE ONLY) or take a wool hold and ride for six (6) seconds. Child may use one or two hands, with one-hand rides receiving more points. Child must ride for six (6) seconds to score and receive points. Sheep shall be chute run, with two contestants per chute. Contestants must NEVER have won a sheep riding contestant at a previous Dodge National Finals Rodeo.

ONE HELPER PER CONTESTANT WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CHUTE AREA, HELPERS AND CONTESTANTS MUST DRESS WESTERN (LONG-SLEEVE SHIRT, WESTERN BOOTS AND WESTERN HAT.) NO SPURS ALLOWED. ANY VIOLATIONS OF THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

EACH APPLICANT DRAWN WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$10 ENTRY FEE TO BE PAID AT WEIGH IN TIME.
